



# AIRBALTIC – RECORD PASSENGER GROWTH IN THE BALTIC REGION

In the first five months of 2017, the Latvian airline *airBaltic* has transported 29% more passengers from Lithuania and Estonia compared to the same period a year before.

From January until May, *airBaltic* has transported a record number of passengers – 146,116 customers from Estonia, the highest number since the beginning of operations in Estonia. In the meantime, *airBaltic* has transported 136,270 passengers from Lithuania throughout its network spanning across Europe, Scandinavia, Russia, CIS and the Middle East.
