



## AERO SOUTH AFRICA 2023 – RIGHT PLACE – RIGHT TIME

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The 3rd edition of AERO South Africa concluded with a very positive impact on the Southern African general aviation sector. The event was held at the Wonderboom National Airport in the City of Tshwane and attracted 60 exhibitors including leading aircraft manufacturers and distributors as well as manufacturers of parts and accessories. The event also attracted 2981 trade visitors from 21 countries. For the first time, the exhibitor satisfaction on visitor numbers and quality surpassed 90% in each category.
