The annual meeting is the continent's leading event for the African Aerospace and Defence industries which meet for a conference and 100-exhibitor strong exhibition. Aviation Africa is taking place in Kigali from 27 & 28 February 2019, at the Radisson Blu Hotel and Convention Centre.
