Upon entering the elegant new lobby, guests are welcomed into a space where contemporary design meets elevated comfort. The facility features an upscale passenger lounge, a fully equipped executive conference room with seating for 14 and full A/V, a private movie theater, a recreation lounge complete with a pool table, private shower suites, and a complimentary beverage bar. Supporting the terminal is a new 30,000-square-foot hangar providing secure, premium storage for both transient and based aircraft. The hangar is capable of accommodating a Bombardier Global 8000, ensuring Sky X can support a wide range of business aviation operations. Phase two of construction is slated for completion in fall 2026 and will feature two additional 30,000-square-foot hangars, each also capable of accommodating a Bombardier Global 8000.
