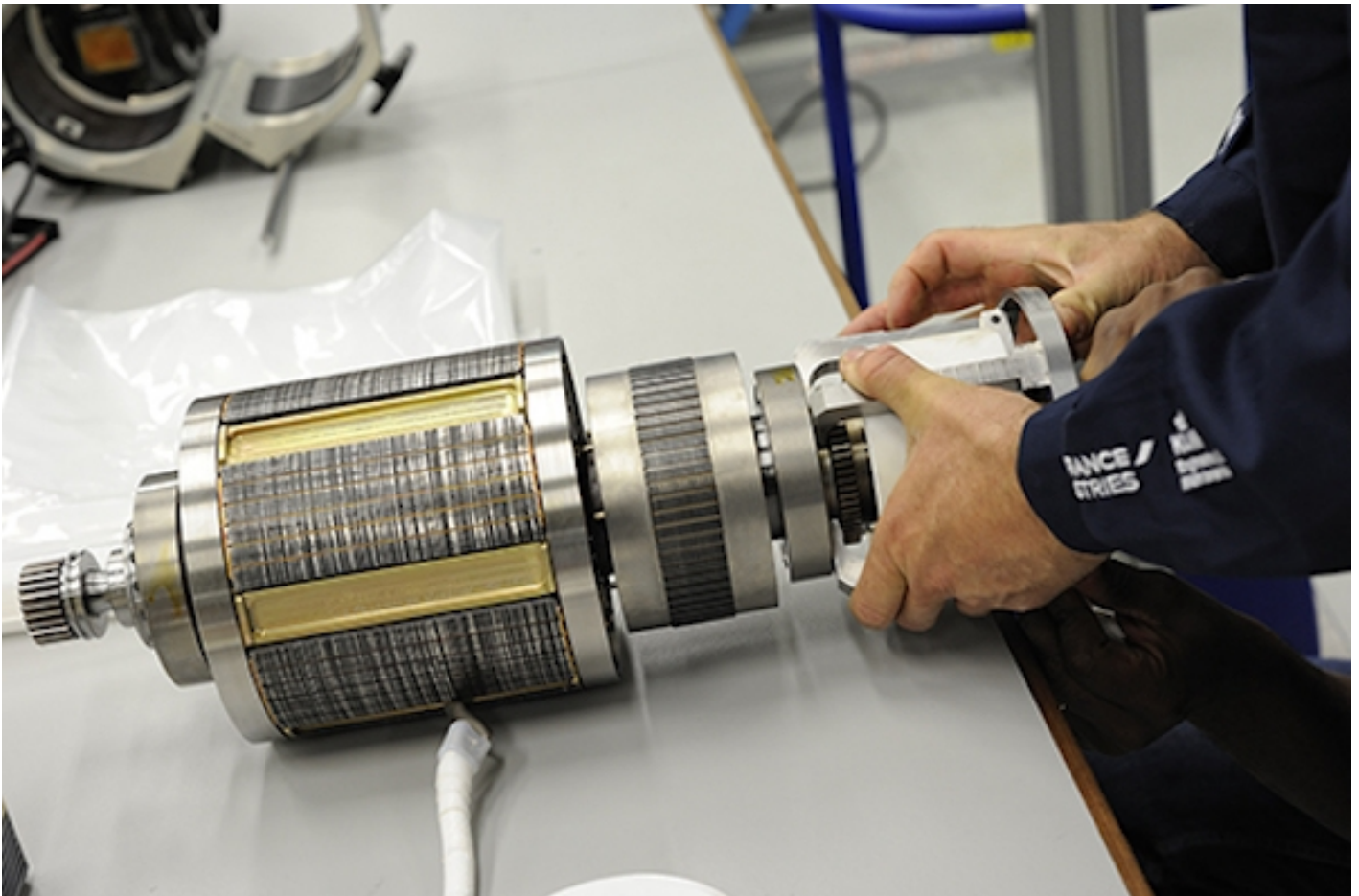

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Extending a long-standing relationship, two contracts, organizing component and engine support for the French carrier's fleet of four Boeing 787-9s were signed between AFI KLM E&M and Air Tahiti Nui .The solutions delivered by the MRO group include repairs and pool access for the Component Support aspect, shop visits, engineering and logistics support for the nine GEnx-1B powerplants equipping Air Tahiti Nui's 787-9s, and line maintenance support at airports in Los Angeles, Paris, and Narita.
