The addition of the new Tecnam P2008 aircraft offers significant benefits for ATP Integrated students:

Fleet standardization

With a unified fleet of Tecnam P2008 single-engine piston (SEP) aircraft with glass cockpits, learning times reduce and the student learning curve improves by over 30%. This standardisation simplifies training procedures and improves overall flight training outcomes on Quality Fly's ATP Integrated Program. By the same token, moving into the MEP & IFR training in their Tecnam P2006 aircraft is a smoother transition.

The fleet facilitates the implementation of Quality Fly's new innovative ATP Integrated program. The program features a distinct separation between theory and flight training, with a "slot flight planning system". This is aimed at optimizing flight schedules and reducing downtime.

All the new Tecnam P2008 aircraft are equipped with [FLARM technology](#), ensuring they align with the safety standards of the rest of the fleet. FLARM provides real-time collision avoidance, contributing to a safer flying environment for ATP Integrated students and instructors alike.

These additions to the fleet mark a key milestone in Quality Fly's mission to provide state-of-the-art ATP Integrated training for future commercial airline pilots, enhancing the quality, efficiency and safety of the training experience.
