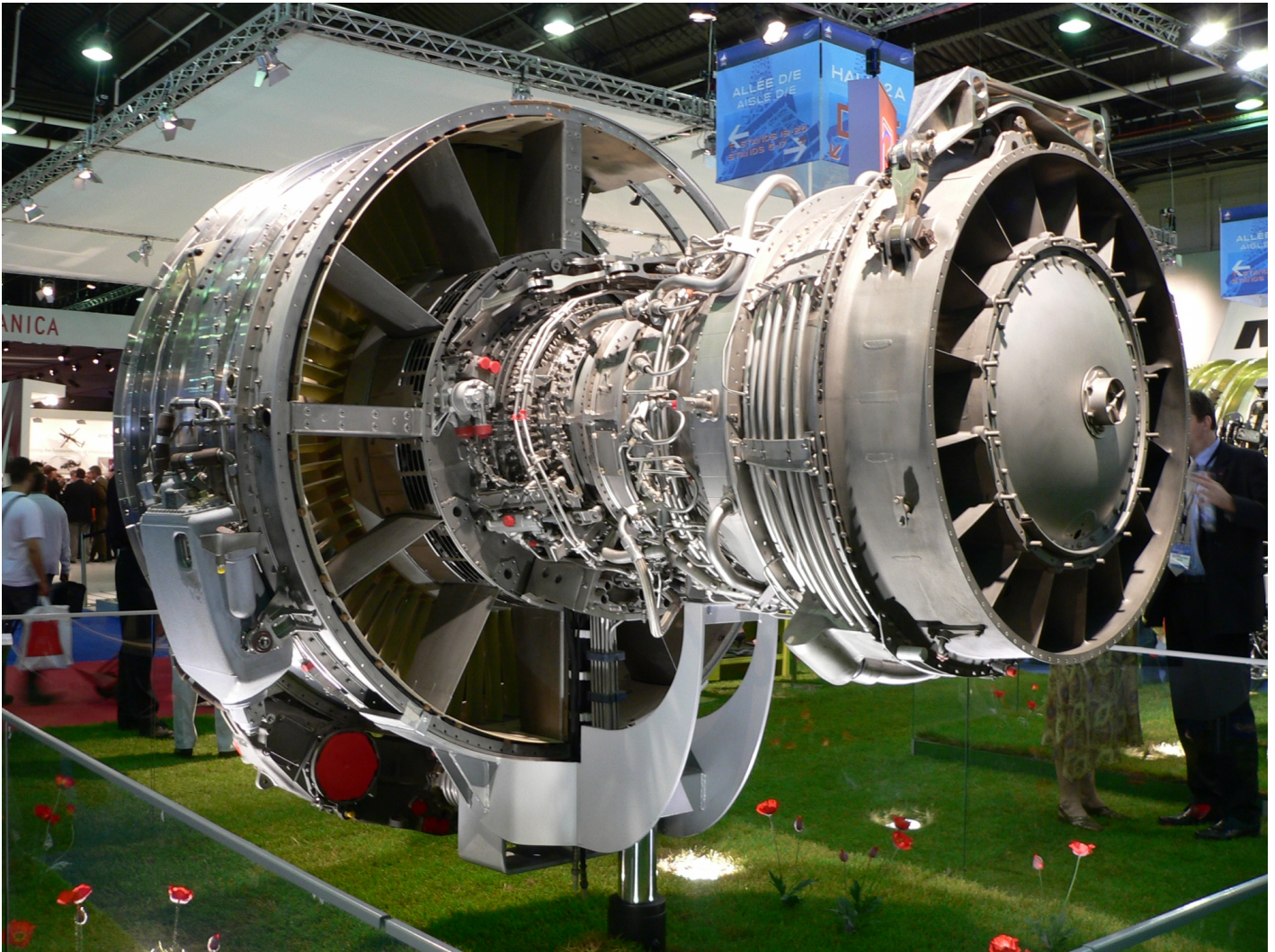




SR TECHNICS WILL PROVIDE MRO SERVICES FOR AIRBUS FAMILY CFM56 ENGINES TILL 2024

The MOU confirms that SR Technics will maintain, repair and overhaul both airberlin's Airbus A330 PW4000-100" (PW4168) and its **Airbus 320 CFM56 engines until 2024**. This represents a five-year extension of the existing Engine Services contract with a value in excess of US\$450 million over the term of the contract.
