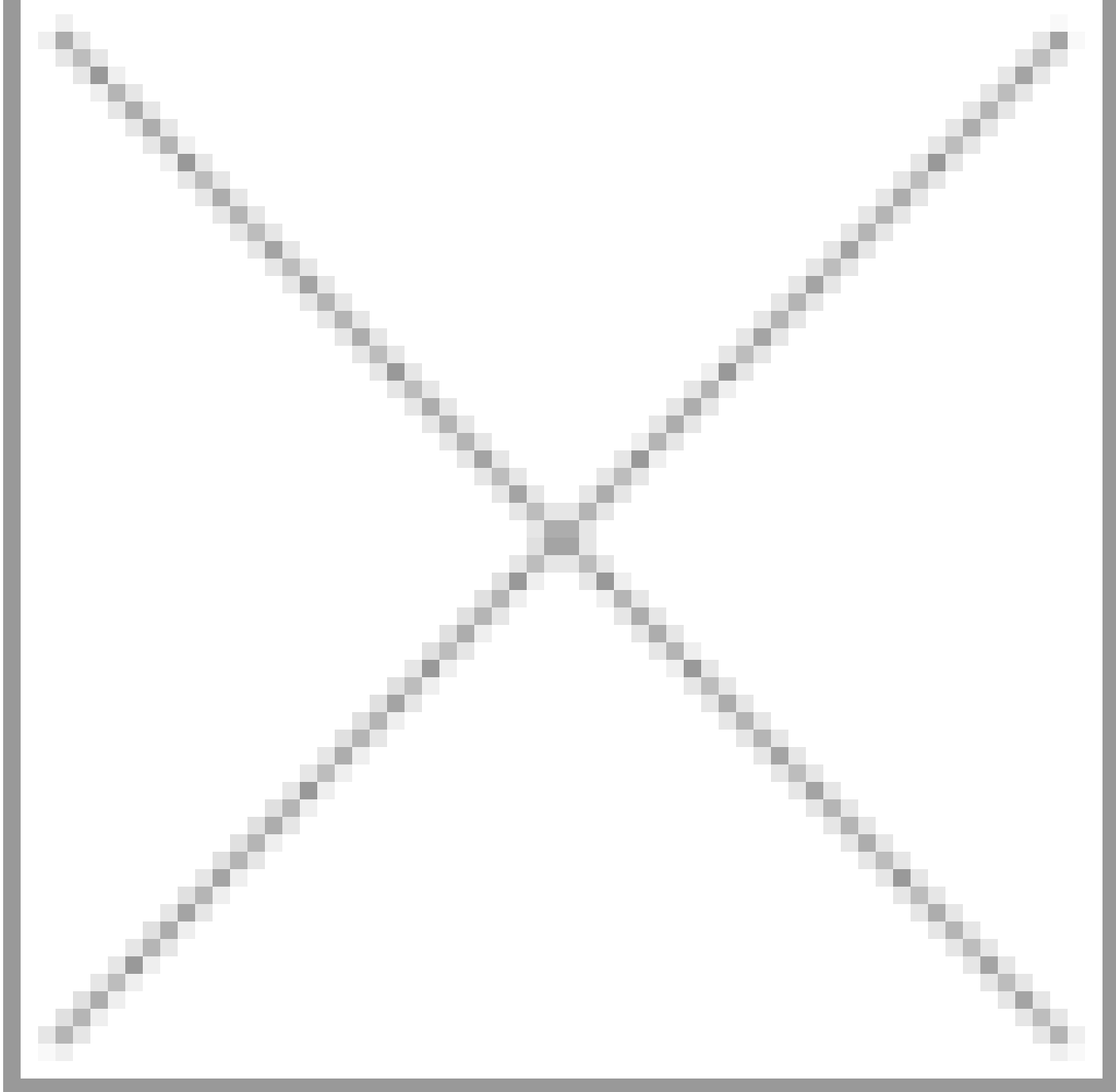
He has significant experience within the MR&O industry and also held positions in operational improvement advisory services and within the investment banking industry.
